BOAT PARADE ENTRY



SITUATION AWARENESS

United States Coast Guard Auxiliary Commander, John Randall IV, has given me assignment of duty to prepare an article on situation awareness in light of the four recent US Naval accidents between February 2017 and August 2017. They have been blamed on lack of training and situation awareness. Total of 17 sailors have lost their lives. Twelve sailors have been relieved of duty, including the commanding officer. The Rear Admiral of the 7th Naval Fleet has taken early retirement because of this. For the US Coast Guard, operational awareness means maritime domain awareness of the environment, weather, and other vessels in the surrounding area.
