#### What is it?

A: The biceps muscle extends from the shoulder to the elbow. It helps to flex the forearm and supinate it from palm down to palm up (like holding up a cup of soup). It has 2 heads that attach at the shoulder: the long head and the short head. When one of these tendons tears , there is still most functionality and strength preserved without surgery. However ...
