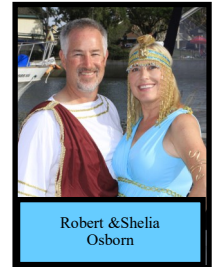

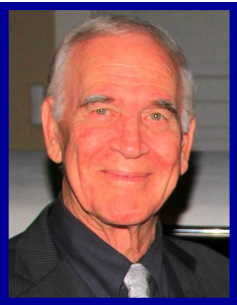
DR. MARK MONROE, COMMODORE

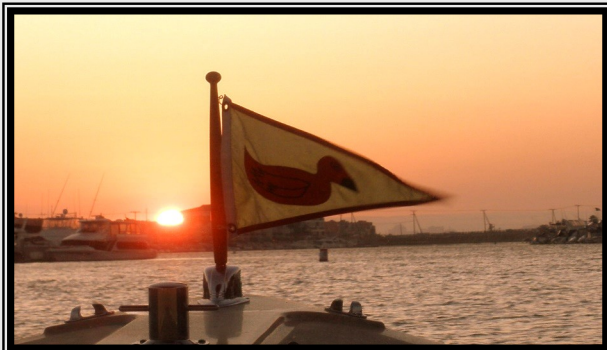
