CPR class on June 6, 2020 at HHYC

In our next CPR class on Saturday, June 6th, 2020, we are going to be teaching new changes in CPR.

What does RAB-CAB stand for? R = responsive? A = activate EMS
B = breathing? - C = compressions A = airway B = breaths.

As soon as AED arrives, turn it on and follow its voice prompts. Continue performing CPR and use the AED until either the victim moves, reacts, and begins breathing, or EMS or another person takes over, or you are just too exhausted to continue.
